

Reading Lists Users Save Students More Than \$65,000


Reading Lists allows instructors to add Georgia Tech Library resources, web resources, and their own documents to a single place in Canvas. Students then find all of their course materials in one place.


Registration Open for Summer K-12 Programs

Science, technology, engineering, art, and mathematics programs will take place in Atlanta and Savannah this summer for elementary, middle, and high school students.


